Everyman Website: Update

Over the summer holidays (July/August) all members whose email addresses are on the membership database, were given their own personal log-in for the site.

Please note that it is important that you change your password at the earliest opportunity. You should have been sent a system generated email which contains both your personal username and password.

You can then login using the *Member Login* facility, halfway down the left-hand menu on the Everyman Theatre homepage (www.everymantheatre.co.uk)

Once you are logged in you can easily change your password by taking the following steps:

- * Click on *Your Details* on the *User Menu* (left-hand side again)
- * Enter your new password
- * Repeat your new password to verify it.
- * Press *Save* to keep the changes you have just made
